

Minerals Road – Mineral Exploration

The Town has received an application to conduct mineral exploration southeast of Minerals Road, and northwest of Wych Hazel Pond; along the ridge at the top of Minerals Road


The exploration activity will involve soil and rock geochemistry/sampling, bore hole drilling, trenching and aerial geophysics studies by helicopters. The exploration program may include up to 7 bore holes (less than 100mm in diameter) to a maximum depth of 750m to remove core samples and up to 225 linear metres of trenching to a depth of up to 4m to remove topsoil and glacial till to acquire samples. The applicant advises that approximately 40,000 litres of water would be used per day during operations; process water would be sourced from nearby surface supplies under a water use license from the provincial government. Used water would be treated for removal of silt and other contaminants and released back to area where it was sourced. Further information is available by contacting the Town as noted below.

The Town is considering the application under its discretionary authority, and prior to a decision, is seeking feedback from the community about the application.
