I am pleased to inform you that a decision has been made by the Town Clerk for to provide access to some of the requested information. In particular, access is granted to the following records:

Access to the remaining records, and/or information contained within the records, has been refused in accordance with the following exceptions to disclosure, as specified in the *Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (the Act):

Disclosure harmful to personal privacy

40. (1) The head of a public body shall refuse to disclose personal information to an applicant where the disclosure would be an unreasonable invasion of a third party's personal privacy.

As required by 8(2) of the Act, we have severed information that is unable to be disclosed and have provided you with as much information as possible.

In accordance with your request for a copy of the records, the appropriate copies have been enclosed.

Please be advised that you may appeal this decision and ask the Information and Privacy Commissioner to review the decision to provide partial access to the requested information, as set out in section 42 of the Act (a copy of this section of the Act has been enclosed for your reference). A request to the Commissioner must be made in writing within 15 business days of the date of this letter or within a longer period that may be allowed by the Commissioner. Your appeal should identify your concerns with the request and why you are submitting the appeal.

L Remarks Local Option

On 05 January 2018 at 03:37:01 hrs the CBS FD was dispatched to 312 Fowler's Road for a reported possible residential structure fire. The call originated from Central.

The location is a residential dwelling.

Upon arrival A/Lt. C. Duke in P1 assumed command. Command was transferred to Lt Fagan on arrival of P2 at 03:55:17 hrs.

The incident was determined to be a residential building fire, with smoke showing on the main floor of the dwelling on arrival. Occupants were out of home on arrival of FD. FD made entry and determined fire in the attic. FD used 1 1/2" pre-connect off P1 to extinguish. Over haul was completed to check for fire extension and hot spots in insulation. 2nd 1 1/2" backup line charged and laid to doorway. PPV Fan was used to aid in ventilation and Decon.

The following actions were performed on scene:

1. Establish command
2. Extinguish fire by FD personal
3. Gather info

Scene turned over to RNC Constable Myers.

Other agencies on scene included Fewer's Ambulance arrival at 04:05:47 hrs and RNC arrival at 03:45:31 hrs.

All units cleared at 05:48:30 hrs and command terminated.

Volunteers were toned out for this call.
