

The Conception Bay South CLB Old Comrades Lodge #2 was founded on September 27, 1983. There is one Old Comrades Lodge in Conception Bay South. The objectives of the association are:

- 1) To provide a forum whereby members and volunteers may provide assistance in furthering the cause of the Church Lads Brigade in Conception Bay South and throughout the world;
- 2) To encourage and promote good fellowship and recreation among all members and ex-members of the CLB.

The Club presently has 45 members, about 25 attend meetings regularly. The group holds one general meeting a month, plus one executive meeting a month at All Saints Anglican Church Parish Hall, Foxtrap. For the past 26 years they have aided our three Conception Bay South CLB Companies in the form of monetary donations for company activities and summer camps, by providing the CLB Wilderness Camp for weekend outings and providing financial assistance for CLB members in need. The group supports Conception Bay South Monument of Honour, Janeway Telethon, Children's Wish Foundation, Daffodil Place, the Kiwanis Club Christmas Parade effort, local affiliated churches, and responds to requests for aid in support of sick or needy individuals in the community. In all that they do, they promote comradery amongst members.
