

ANTI LITTER REGULATIONS

PUBLISHED BY AUTHORITY

Pursuant to the authority conferred by the Municipalities Act, 1999, chapter M-24, Section 414(2)(pp) the Town of Conception Bay South has made the following Anti Litter Regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. TITLE

These regulations shall be known and cited as "Town of Conception Bay South Anti Litter Regulations".

2. INTERPRETATION

In these Regulations:

- (a) **"Regulations"** means the Town of Conception Bay South Anti Litter Regulations.
- (b) **"Authorized Receptacle"** means a litter storage or collection receptacle as required by the Garbage Regulations or as may be approved by the Town of Conception Bay South.
- (c) **"Council"** means the Town Council of the Town of Conception Bay South.
- (d) **"Hand Bill"** means printed or written matter, circular, sample, advertisement, leaflet or paper other than a newspaper or Her Majesty's mail.
- (e) **"Litter"** means any obnoxious substance, waste or unsanitary matter, refuse, garbage, rubbish, ashes, street cleanings, dead animals, paper wrappings, cardboard boxes, tin cans, leaves, wood, bedding, crockery, glass bottles and glass in all its forms,

cement bags and bags of all description and other matter or thing which if thrown or deposited as herein prohibited tends, or is likely to cause or causes unsightliness within the Town or creates a danger to health, welfare or public safety and includes abandoned vehicles, furniture and appliances.

- (f) **“Person”** means any person, firm, partnership association, corporation, company or organization of any kind.
- (g) **“Town”** means the Town of Conception Bay South.
- (h) **“Waste”** means rubbish, offal, slime, tailings, effluent, sludge, sewage, garbage, refuse, scrap, litter or other substances or waste products that would or could cause an adverse effect;

3. APPLICATION

These regulations shall apply within the boundaries of the Town.

4. LITTER

No person shall throw or deposit litter or waste upon any street, sidewalk or other public place, or upon private property, or pond, river or stream within the Town except in authorized receptacles for collection. This will include Hand Bill material delivered to residential and business locations. All Hand Bill material shall be deposited in a mailbox or in the absence of a mailbox to the front door of a residence or the door of a business.

5. PLACEMENT OF LITTER IN RECEPTACLES

Persons placing litter in authorized receptacles shall do so in such a manner as to prevent it from being carried or deposited by the elements upon any street, sidewalk or other public place, or upon private property, or pond, river or stream.

6. SWEEPING LITTER INTO GUTTERS PROHIBITED

- (a) No person shall sweep into or deposit into any gutter, street or other public place within the Town the accumulation of litter from any building or lot or from any public or private sidewalk or driveway. Persons owning or occupying property shall keep the sidewalk in front of their premises free of litter.

- (b) No person owning or occupying a place of business shall sweep into or deposit into any gutter, street or other public place within the Town the accumulation of litter from any building or lot, or from any public or private sidewalk or driveway. Persons owning or occupying places of business within the Town shall keep the sidewalk or parking area free of litter.
- (c) Nothing in this Section or in Section 9 shall prohibit persons from watering sidewalks, gutters, or street fronting their premises in order to minimize or control the spreading and flow of dust.

7. LITTER THROWN BY PERSONS IN VEHICLES

No person while a driver or passenger in a vehicle shall throw or deposit litter of any description upon any street or other public or upon private property within the Town.

8. TRUCK LOADS CAUSING LITTER

No person shall drive or move any truck or other vehicle within the Town unless such vehicle is so constructed or loaded so as to prevent any load, contents or litter from being blown or deposited upon any street, sidewalk or other public place within the Town.

9. LITTER IN PARKS

No person shall throw or deposit litter in any park within the Town, except in authorized receptacles and in such a manner that the litter will be prevented from being carried or deposited by the elements upon any part of the park or upon any street or other public place or private property. Where authorized receptacles are not provided, all such litter shall be carried away from the park by the person responsible for its presence and properly disposed of elsewhere as provided herein.

10. LITTER IN WATERWAYS

No person shall throw or deposit litter in any ditch, pond or stream or other body of water within the Town.

11. POSTING NOTICES PROHIBITED

No person shall post or affix any notice, poster or other matter or device calculated to attract the attention of the public to any lamp post, public utility pole, tree, or upon any public structure or building except as may be authorized by Council, or required by law.

12. LITTER ON PRIVATE PROPERTY

No person shall throw or deposit litter on any private property within the Town, whether the property is owned by such person or not, except that the owner or person in control of private property may maintain authorized receptacles for collection in such a manner that litter will be prevented from being carried or deposited by the elements upon any street, sidewalk or other public place or upon any private property.

13. PENALTIES

Every person who is guilty of an offence under these Regulations or who acts in contravention of or fails to comply with any provision thereof, or neglects or refuses to do so:

- (a) Shall be liable to penalties as stipulated in accordance with section 420 of the Municipalities Act, 1999; or
- (b) Shall be subject to an order under section 404 (1) (I) of the Municipalities Act, 1999; or
- (c) Shall be subject to a violation notice issued under section 421.1 (1) of the Municipalities Act, 1999; or
- (d) Shall be issued to a ticket under the Provincial Offences Act in accordance with section 421.2 of the Municipalities Act, 1999.

14. REPEAL OF PREVIOUS REGULATIONS AND AMENDMENTS

All previous Town of Conception Bay South Anti Litter Regulations and amendments are repealed.


15. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER ACTS

Nothing in these Regulations serves to exempt any person from obtaining any license, permission, permit, authority or approval required by any other regulation of the Town or any statute or regulation of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, and in such cases where more than one regulation or statute applies the more restrictive regulation or statute shall apply.


16. EFFECTIVE DATE
