

BICYCLE HELMET REGULATIONS

PUBLISHED BY AUTHORITY

Pursuant to the authority conferred by the Municipalities Act, 1999, chapter M-24, Section 414(2) (jj) (iii), the Town of Conception Bay South has made the following Regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. TITLE

These Regulations shall be known and cited as "Town of Conception Bay South Bicycle Helmet Regulations".

2. INTERPRETATION

In these Regulations:

- (a) **"Regulations"** means the Town of Conception Bay South Bicycle Helmet Regulations.
- (b) **"Bicycle"** means every device having two or more tandem wheels propelled by human power.
- (c) **"Council"** means the Council of the Town of Conception Bay South.
- (d) **"Street"** means any street, road or highway or any other way designed for the passage of vehicles and pedestrians that is accessible by fire department and other emergency vehicles.

3. USE OF HELMET

- (a) No person shall ride on or operate a bicycle on a street unless the person is wearing a bicycle helmet that is designed for bicycling use and is approved by the Canadian Standards Association, the Snell Memorial Foundation or the American National Standards Association, except as provided for in subsections 3(b) and 2(c).

- (b) Members of religious communities who, in accordance with their beliefs, are required to wear religious head wear are exempt from the provisions of these Regulations.
- (c) Persons who for medical reasons cannot wear a bicycle helmet and have provided confirmation of same from a licensed physician are exempt from the provisions of these Regulations.
- (d) No parent or guardian of a person under the age of twelve shall authorize or knowingly permit that person to ride on or operate a bicycle on a street unless that person is wearing a bicycle helmet as required by section.

4. PENALTY

Every person who contravenes any of the provision of these Regulations is guilty of an offence and is on summary conviction liable to a minimum fine of \$20.00 up to a maximum fine of \$50.00.

5. REPEAL OF PREVIOUS REGULATIONS AND AMENDMENTS

All previous Town of Conception Bay South Bicycle Helment Regulations and amendments are repealed.


6. COMPLAINE WITH OTHER ACTS AND REGULATIONS

Nothing in these Regulations serves to exempt any person from obtaining any license, permission, permit, authority or approval required by any other regulation of the Town or any statute or regulation of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, and in such cases where more than one regulations or statute applies the more restrictive regulation or statute shall apply.


7. EFFECTIVE DATE
