



**Title: Disposition of Sewage Problems**

**PURPOSE:**

To define the role of Council where it relates to the disposition of sewage related problems.

**AUTHORITY:**

- Sections 156, 159 and 178 of the *Municipalities Act, 1999*

**PROCEDURE:**

Where a health hazard or potential health hazard caused by a malfunctioning or inadequate septic system has been identified by the Department of Health and corrective measures recommended, the Town will order the property owner to have the corrective measures taken within sixty days. Failure to have the work completed within this time period will result in the Town undertaking to have the work carried out and all costs associated with such corrective measures undertaken will be the responsibility of the property owner.
