

ROADS BY-LAW

PUBLISHED BY AUTHORITY

Pursuant to the authority conferred by the Towns and Local Service Districts Act, Chapter T-6.2, Section 8(1)(g), the Town of Conception Bay South has made the following By-law.

BY-LAW

1. TITLE

This By-law shall be known as the Roads By-law.

2. INTERPRETATION

In this By-law:

- (a) **"By-law"** means the Town of Conception Bay South Roads By-law.
- (b) **"Council"** means the Council of the Town of Conception Bay South.
- (c) **"Act"** means the Towns and Local Service Districts Act.
- (d) **"Town"** means Town of Conception Bay South.

3. CONSTRUCTION

Council may construct public highways, sidewalks and bridges and improve, realign, alter the level of, and repair existing public highways, sidewalks and bridges.

4. CLOSING A ROAD

Council may order the closing of a public highway, sidewalk or bridge either temporarily, in order to effect repairs or to prevent damage to the highway, sidewalk or bridge, or permanently, where it considers it necessary to do so.

5. PARKING LOTS

Council may acquire, by agreement or expropriation, real property necessary for parking lots, and may establish and construct parking lots and charge for their use in an amount that it may establish.

6. LIGHTING

Council may provide highway and area lighting within the municipality and may enter into agreements with a person to provide that lighting.

7. MOVEMENT OF VEHICLES

- i) A structure, object or vehicle, other than a vehicle licensed under the *Highway Traffic Act*, shall not move over a public highway or bridge without the written consent of Council.
- ii) Notwithstanding subsection 7(i), a vehicle that is propelled over tracks or other device, other than tires, shall not move over a public road or bridge without the written consent of Council.

8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER ACTS AND REGULATIONS

Nothing in this By-law serves to exempt any person from obtaining any license, permission, permit, authority or approval required by any other By-law of the Town or any statute or regulation of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, and in such cases where more than one regulation or statute applies the more restrictive regulation or statute shall apply.


9. EFFECTIVE DATE
